Toss a pancake and share one of your many talents at this festive supper and talent show.




6 pm at St. Cross. Mardi Gras pancake supper.

6 pm Service in St. Francis Parish Hall with an agape meal and footwashing.


8 pm - 6 am The Watch at St. Cross.
